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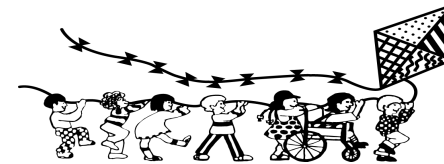

About Parenting the Strong-Willed Child

- You will learn how to facilitate the five skills from Parenting the Strong-Willed Child
- This approach is based on the book Parenting the Strong-Willed Child and Thomas Phelan's 1-2-3 Magic.
- It is required that facilitators have a combination of an academic background (degree in Human services) and experience working with children and families.
- We strongly recommend that all facilitators watch 1,2,3 Magic before the first class (copies available at your local library and Family Hub/Parent Links).
- The class will involve group discussion as well as opportunities to practice facilitating sessions.
- This group offers opportunities to co-facilitate with other community members.

NOTE: This is not a certification program. This course is provided to develop facilitation skills, gain new ideas and strategies beneficial to presenting, and networking opportunities with local community groups/individuals.

There is a limit of 15 per session & deadline for registration is August 21, 2009, so please call as soon as possible

WHO: Professional working with families and children ages 2-6 years of
Age (modifications can be made for 7-12 year olds) whose behavior is resistant and oppositional

WHAT: Parenting the Strong-Willed Child provides facilitators with the clinically proven approach to dealing with a child's inappropriate behavior. Parents learn skills that help build a more positive home, effective communication, develop more patience, and improve their child's self-esteem. These skills include attending, rewarding, ignoring, giving directions and using consequences (1-2-3 Magic).
